WRC Sub-Committee (pro-tem) Meeting March 7th, 2005

You are receiving this announcement because of your stated interest in the World Radio Communications Agenda items WRC-97 and WRC-3. These two resolutions by the WRC with resolution to be put forth to the International Telecommunication Union, has serious impact to our High Frequency Communications industry, customers and users.
