The ICM & HFIA meetings will be held in Room # 2 at the San Diego Convention Center, 111 Harbor Dr., San Diego, California, USA. The ICM will be on Wed. Jan. 31st and the following day, Thur. Feb. 1st will be the HFIA meeting. We will gather at 8:00 AM each day. Continental breakfast items consisting of coffee, juices and bread items will be available in the meeting room.
