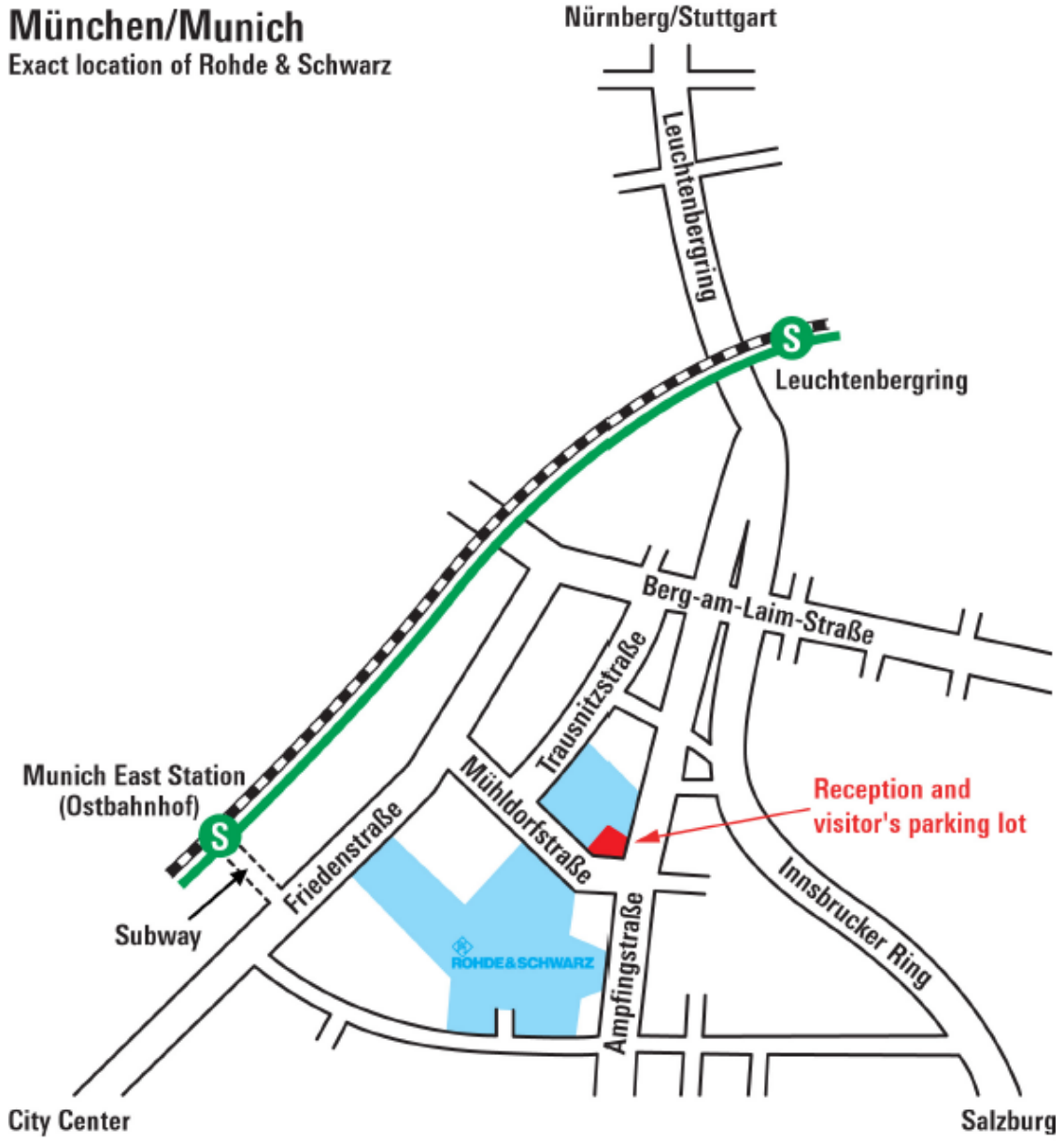

There is no registration or fee to attend the HFIA meeting itself however we would appreciate an E-mail indicating your planned attendance.

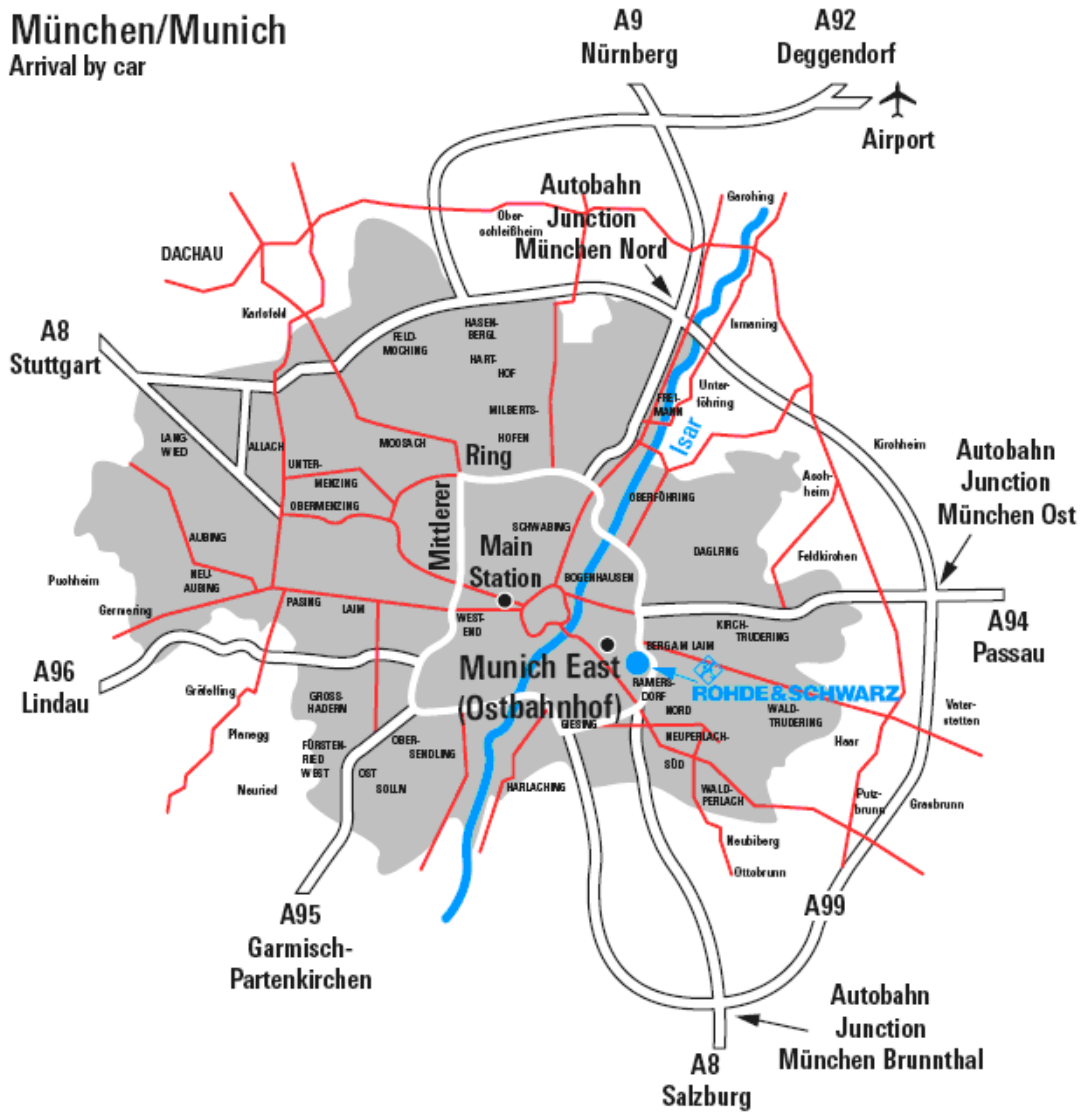
The meeting will be held at the Rohde & Schwarz facility. Directions to the meeting location are shown in the maps below.

Exact location of Rohde & Schwarz

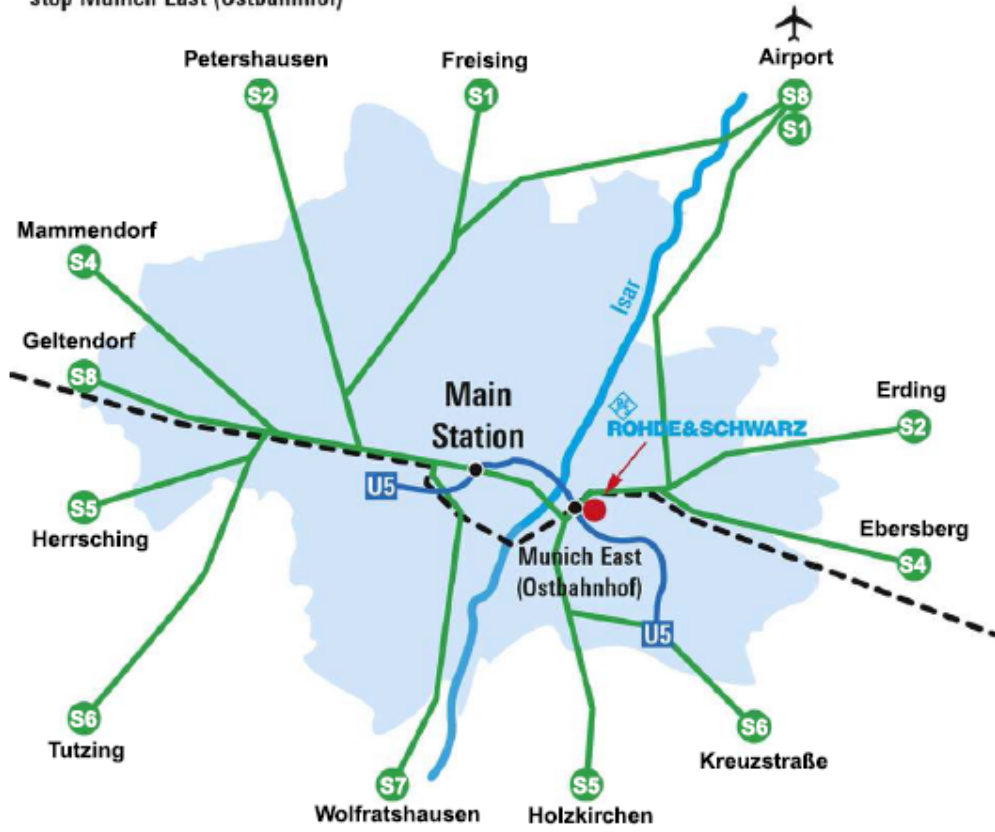


München/Munich Arrival by car
